
HOW TO PREPARE YOUR WALL



Preparing your wall prior to installation ensures a good adhesion and a quality look and feel. We do not recommend installing your mural without first preparing your wall.

Plastered Walls

- 1. Ensure the wall is clean and dry with no loose plaster. Use a damp sponge to wash your wall down and let dry fully.
- 2. To help seal a porous surface, we recommend you seal your wall with a quality primer/sealer

Painted Walls

- 1. We recommend you install your mural on top of matt emulsion paint only.
- 2. If your wall has cracked or flakey paint we recommend the surface be correctly prepared with a quality primer/sealer.
- 3. Freshly painted walls should be left for 2-3 weeks to dry out completely before installing your mural.

Papered Walls

- 1. We recommend you remove any old wallpaper, if not your mural may not stick to the wall.
- 2. Do not use a lining paper on your wall Peel and Stick installations only.
