


INSTALLING YOUR MURAL



What You'll Need

Wallpaper Murals

- Tape Measure
- Spirit Level
- Pencil
- Roller
- Soft Brush
- Sharp Blade
- Soft Cloth
- Wallpaper Paste


Peel and Stick Murals

- Tape Measure
- Spirit Level
- Pencil
- Sharp Knife

- Ensure your wall is perfectly clean, the wall must be smooth and free from any texture - IMPORTANT - before you begin installation, please read our How To Prepare your Wall instruction sheet.
- Using a spirit level, draw a straight vertical line on your wall, a panel's width in from the edge of the wall. Deduct the 5cm extra you added to your measurements for the bleed as this will help you guide the panel into place.



- For Premium Wallpaper Murals apply the supplied wallpaper paste directly to the area the first panel will be placed, using a medium pile roller.
- For Peel & Stick Murals, carefully peel a small amount of the mural at the top from the backing paper and apply the top of the panel to the wall, ensuring the right hand edge aligns with your vertical line. Carefully peel away the rest of the mural and gently apply to the wall working down towards the bottom of the panel. Gently smooth out the mural as you go.
- Hang the first panel, letting the wallpaper fall naturally and smooth out with a soft brush to remove any trapped air bubbles.



- Your mural is NOT printed with an overlap so on hanging your 2nd and subsequent panels, ensure you butt up the edges ensuring the image matches up as you go.



- When butting panels together, gently place the panel into position, edge to edge and adjust as necessary, ensuring there are no visible gaps.
- Ensure the image matches up as you apply each panel.
- Follow the process on each panel of smoothing out any trapped air bubbles with a soft brush.
- Continue until you have installed all the panels.
- When installing a Premium Wallpaper Mural, gently wipe away any excess paste using a soft damp cloth.
- Finally, trim away the excess at the top, bottom and sides of your mural with a sharp blade.
